#### Committees, Task Forces and Advisory Groups

A large number of volunteers continue to assist IFOMPT in performing a range of activities and ensuring it remains on track with its strategic goals and direction.

- The Standards Committee has conducted several IM reviews, was responsible for the content of the Teachers Meeting and is involved with EC in the future direction of the ESD and IM.

The survey will run until the end of January 2024, while the EC and SC will work on the proposed new structure to be ready to present it to the membership in Basel in July 2024. As always, the members will be kept involved and informed as we develop the proposal.

Various calls for nominations have gone out with more to follow in 2024. These include nominations for the various IFOMPT awards, the EC and others. Please make sure to check in with your boards and members to nominate candidates for all the awards.

### **2028 CONFERENCE**

France and Canada will proceed to submit formal bids to host IFOMPT 2028. The bids will be forwarded to the MOs for their review and insights that will form part of the evaluation process by 20 February 2024. The successful bidder will be announced in early April 2024.
