Reconnecting

From the President -Laura Finucane



In my last president's message, I spoke to the opening up of the world post Covid-19 and our ability to reconnect with each other face-toface. I talked of the importance of being able to do this. As an EC, we are constitutionally bound to meet in person every two years. No one accounted for a pandemic, but we did seize an opportunity to meet in early September. It seemed the ideal opportunity to fly the rest of the committee to join us.

The days were productive and whilst our regular monthly meetings online are efficient, we achieved far, far more meeting in person. It went beyond the outputs we produced which included a review of the strategy, review of processes related

We were grateful for Lenerdene joining us there along with Eric from the SC. As a consequence, we were able to have some really good meetings discussing future plans and the way forward. We caught up with Haideh (US delegate) a strong delegation from Canada including Michael(delegate), Timmi (South African delegate) and a group from the Philippines.

In the lead up to Basel 2024 we have a number of opportunities to meet, and I would urge you to join us. Paolo, Ingrid and I will attend WP in Dubai in June 2023 where we will have a trade stand and host a networking session. Ahead of Basel we will be in Ghent (https://www.mathera.be/nl/content /countdown) in September 2023 and we intend to hold a delegate assembly on 13 September 2023. This requires you to ensure you send a delegate to represent your country. Whilst our AMO and RIGs are not required to attend, we would encourage you to attend, where possible. Many of our MO delegates are new to their role and this is an ideal opportunity to connect and meet in person. The SC are putting together a cutting-edge Teachers Meeting in Ghent that will take place on 14 September 2023.

The next few years we are set to connect, and I am looking forward to seeing many of you soon.
