

Required Documents for RIG Status within IFOMPT

For 'Registered Interest Group' status within IFOMPT, it will be necessary to provide the following information to the office at admin@ifompt.org:

- 1. A letter from the National Physiotherapy Association, which is a Member of WCPT, stating all members of the group are financial members of the Parent Body.
- 2. The group should submit a Constitution and a Code of Conduct.
- 3. A document containing:
 - a. the number of members in the group, with names and addresses of Office Bearers.; and
 - b. a declaration that all members agree to abide by the Constitution and Bylaws of IFOMPT.
- 4. A Registered Interest Group may be approved by the Executive Committee.
- 5. Once the Executive Committee has approved the applicant as a RIG of IFOMPT, the annual membership fee applicable to RIGs is payable.

Note that examples of MO Constitutions and Codes of Conduct that illustrate various organisational structures are available by contacting the IFOMPT Executive Director.
