

Required Documents for AMO Status within IFOMPT

For 'Associate Member Organisation' status within IFOMPT, it will be necessary to provide a formal application containing the following information to the office at <u>admin@ifompt.org</u>:

- 1. A letter from the National Physiotherapy Association, which is a Member of WCPT, stating all members of the group are financial members of the Parent Body and endorsing the AMO as the sole IFOMPT representative of their country.
- 2. The group should submit a Constitution and a Code of Conduct.
- 3. A document containing:
 - a. the number and composition of members in the group, with names and addresses of Office Bearers.; and
 - b. a declaration that all members agree to abide by the Constitution and Bylaws of IFOMPT.
- 4. Proof that the group is developing and has made substantial progress with their OMPT curriculum.
- 5. Confirmation of umbrella arrangements if there is more than one group in the country.

Note that all members must be physiotherapists.

An Associate Member Organisation may be approved by the Executive Committee.

Once the Executive Committee has approved the applicant as an AMO of IFOMPT, the annual

membership fee applicable to AMOs is payable.
